
Goal 7 - Ensure environmental sustainability

Target: Reverse the loss of environmental resources

Carbon dioxide (CO₂) emissions

Worldwide emissions of CO₂ — the largest single source of greenhouse gas emissions from human activities — hardly changed on a per capita basis.

GLOBAL EMISSION OF CARBON DIOXIDE



Chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs)

Since the adoption of the Montreal Protocol in 1986, the global consumption of CFCs — the major substances causing depletion of the ozone layer — has decreased significantly.
